

## Sci-Tech Discovery Center Covid-19 Policies for Staff and Guests

### Here is What Sci-Tech is Doing to Ensure Your Safety:

- Sci-Tech will make hand sanitizer, disinfecting wipes, soap and water, or similar disinfectant readily available.
- All tables, seats, and supplies to be used by guests and program participants will be sanitized by staff before and after the program run time.
- Sci-Tech staff will sanitize supplies to be used by program participants. Program participants will have assigned supplies such as markers, scissors, and goggles. These will be sanitized daily.
- Overall capacity will be held at 50% or less in accordance with state and local guidelines.
- Exhibit pieces will be sanitized by Sci-Tech staff throughout the day.

### Here is What We are Asking All Guests and Staff to Do to Ensure the Safety of Others:

- Temperature checks will be required when applicable. Anyone with a temperature reading 100.4 F or higher will be asked to return home.
- As mandated by state and local Government those ages 10 and older are required to wear a face covering (over nose and mouth).
- Everyone should sanitize hands as often as possible. Hand sanitizer and disinfecting soap will be provided throughout the museum.
- Guests not from the same household should remain at least 6 feet from other guests at all times.

### Those Who Meet any of the following Criteria May Not Enter the Sci Tech Discovery Center:

- If you are experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19 (including fever, chills, cough, shortness of breath, headache muscle pain, or sore throat)
- If you or a close family member tests positive for COVID-19
- If you have come in contact with anyone that has a known or suspected case of COVID-19

### Those who Meet the Criteria Mentioned Above May Not Return to Sci-Tech until:

- In the case of a person who was diagnosed with COVID-19, the individual may return when all three of the following criteria are met: at least 3 days (72 hours) have passed *since recovery* (resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications); and the individual has improvement in respiratory symptoms (e.g., cough, shortness of breath); and at least 7 days have passed *since symptoms first appeared*; or
- A person with known close contact to a person who is lab-confirmed to have COVID-19 may *not* return until the end of the 14-day self-quarantine period from the last date of exposure.
